

ACT PREPARATION CLASS

SPRING SESSION: April 14-28

The purpose of this course is to provide students with strategies and appropriate strategy practice for the ACT. Cost of the course is \$100.00 per student. The lessons are as follows:

April 14

English Review - Dr. Carrie Pfeifer

Review and practice the 10 most important English rules for grammar, punctuation, and rhetoric that correlate with the English Test problems.

Science Review - Mr. Jeff Strehlow

Practice with the strategies for interpreting graphs and charts, reasoning data representation, research summaries, and conflicting viewpoints as applied to scientific based readings.

April 21

Math Review - Mr. Jon Harley

Basic formulas and facts from pre-algebra, algebra I and II, and trigonometry are discussed, and mathematical concepts are applied to the ACT Mathematics Test problems.

Reading Strategies - Dr. Carrie Pfeifer

The students will aggressively outline the genres of reading passages and discuss the four types of questions on the ACT Reading Test: Main Idea, Fact, Inference, and Tone.

Writing Test - Dr. Carrie Pfeifer

Review of effective strategies for writing and practice in writing the ACT essay.

Practice Test – Dr. Carrie Pfeifer

Students will complete an ACT practice test in order to evaluate areas of strengths and weaknesses.
